STUDENTS

HEALTH – EXAMINATIONS

In compliance with state health regulations, the Board requires health assessments as follows:

1. Prior to enrollment – Physical examination to include HgB/HCT urinalysis, blood pressure, height and weight; updating required immunization; and vision, hearing, dental screening, and chronic disease assessment.
2. Grade 6 – As above with the addition of postural screening. Proof of compliance is required prior to entering grade 7.
3. Sports physicals – During academic year prior to participation in interscholastic sports.

Assessments may be privately provided and documented, or provided directly through the school medical advisor. If provided in school, parents will be notified and given the opportunity to attend, to provide the examination privately or to exempt the student on religious grounds. The Board will provide for required health assessment free of charge to students eligible for Federal free lunch or free milk.

Notice of any disease or defect found by the medical advisor shall be given to the parents or guardian with such advice or order deemed advisable by the medical advisor.
